**Call to Order:** The committee chair called the meeting to order at 2:01 p.m.

A motion was raised to approve the minutes from the October 12, 2022 meeting. The motion was passed with nine members in favor.

### Announcements

### How the Library Supports Deaf Studies – Librarian Nancy Young and Anthony Ivankovic (Time certain 2:15 p.m.)

- CSUN Deaf Studies Subject Specialist Librarian Nancy Young shared an overview of [Deaf Studies Databases and Lib Guides](#).
- Automated Storage and Retrieval System (ASRS) Lead Anthony Ivankovic discussed the Deaf Studies Collection and how the Library serves students, including:
  - Deaf Studies overview
  - OneSearch, ScholarWorks, and ASRS
  - Two deaf role models on the Library's staff that use sign language
- Future plans and ideas include establishing a central archive for deaf-related materials, digitization of old videos and formats, and a specialized librarian.

### Library Strategic Plan Focus Group – Librarian Nicole Shibata (Time certain 2:30 p.m.)

- A Strategic Planning Task Force was developed to capture the opinions of faculty.
- Three questions were posed to FSLC members to gather feedback:
  1. What has been your best experience with the Library, and what made the experience so positive?
  2. What could the Library do to contribute to your students' academic success, and your own success as an educator and researcher?
  3. Beyond their academic success, what do you think the Library's role should be in supporting students holistically in their professional, critical, and creative abilities?

### **Dean's Report**

- The Library has made great progress on the [CSUN Leaders Oral History Project](#). Many interviews have been conducted, including the early leaders of the University.
- A mural installation in the Library is being planned to honor the Fernandeano Tataviam Band of Mission Indians. \$50,000 in funds has been raised to support this project. An RFP was developed in consultation with the University Art Collection Commission. A selection panel will be assigned to review artist applications. The estimated mural installation is expected in summer 2023.
- The Library will be celebrating GIS Day on November 16 in collaboration with the Geography Department. Event details TBA.
